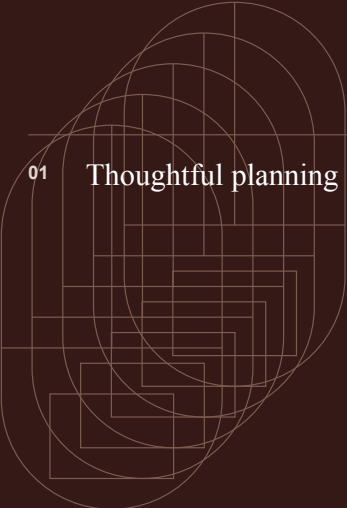

A well-resolved design can prevent one wrong cabinet run, clearance issue, or finish decision from becoming an expensive construction change.

What is included.

Each deliverable supports a more informed, coordinated, and confident build.

01

Cabinetry plans

Detailed layouts establish cabinetry dimensions, spacing, and overall organization so your build team has clear direction.

03

Fixtures and finishes

Key appliances, plumbing fixtures, lighting, countertops, paint colors, wood tones, tile, and flooring are considered together.

Live revision session

A one-hour video call gives us time to review your feedback, compare options, and refine the details together.

Floor plans

Thoughtful plans confirm clearances, door swings, and natural movement through the room before construction begins.

04

Photorealistic renderings

Realistic views show the intended cabinetry, materials, fixtures, proportions, and atmosphere within your actual space.

Private digital gallery

Your drawings, renderings, and project references are organized for easy review, download, and sharing with your contractor.

Reserve your project

Approve the proposal and complete secure checkout. Your place in the design queue is then reserved.

02

Share plans and inspiration

Send dimensioned plans when available, along with photos, inspiration images, preferences, and project notes. If plans are unavailable, we will help identify the best way to document the space.

03

Meet for kickoff

We schedule a focused conversation to confirm your priorities, review the information, and align on the direction before design begins.

04

Review the initial design

Once the required information is complete, we develop your drawings and renderings. The initial design is typically prepared within 10 business days.

05

Refine and receive

We gather your feedback, meet for the live revision session, complete the included revision round, and organize the final package for delivery.

Questions, answered.

The details below set clear expectations and help your project begin smoothly.

Why design in 3D first?

Many layout, cabinetry, fixture, and finish decisions become costly to change once construction begins. Planning and visualizing them first allows the design to be refined while it is still flexible.

Can my contractor or cabinetmaker handle the design?

Your builder and cabinetmaker are experts at execution. The design package defines what is being built - including the layout, cabinetry, materials, and how the elements work together - so they can plan and quote with greater clarity.

What if I want to make changes?

Your project includes a one-hour live revision session and one revision round following the initial design. A new layout or substantially different creative direction may require an additional scope and fee.

Do I need floor plans or measurements?

Dimensioned plans are the preferred starting point. If you do not have them, send the information you have and we will explain what additional documentation or room scanning may be needed.

Will the finished space match the renderings exactly?

Renderings communicate the intended design, proportions, materials, lighting, and overall feeling as closely as possible. Final products and site conditions may create slight differences in the completed space.

The details that protect clarity.

Our goal is to make the design useful, transparent, and easy to carry forward with your project team.

Do you help with furniture and decor?

The standard package focuses on the room itself: layout, cabinetry, tile, lighting, finishes, and fixtures. Furniture sourcing, decor, rugs, drapery, and other soft goods are not included unless they are specifically added to the proposal.

Are these construction or fabrication drawings?

We provide dimensioned design drawings for planning and coordination, not final shop or fabrication drawings. Before construction, the appropriate trade professional must field-verify site dimensions and prepare any required shop drawings.

What happens after I book?

You receive payment confirmation, followed by the next-step information for inspiration, project details, plans, or room documentation. Once the required materials are complete, we confirm kickoff and the design schedule.

What is the refund policy?

Your booking reserves time in the design queue. Because work begins promptly and time is specifically allocated to your project, design fees become non-refundable once design work has started.

Can I add more rooms later?

Yes. Additional rooms can be coordinated alongside the booked project when schedule allows. We will confirm the added scope, pricing, and payment before the additional design work begins.
